Education

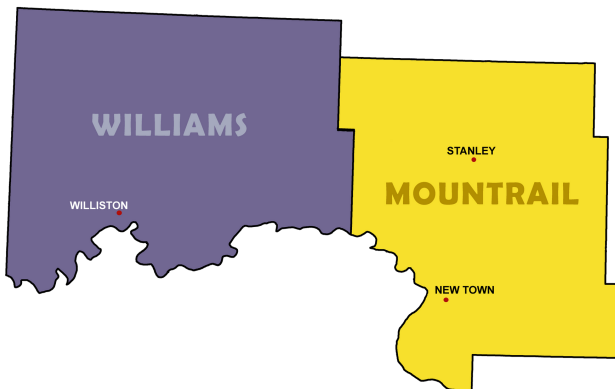
support local educational efforts. Projects may include, but are not limited to, educational facilities.

Purpose

Support new infrastructure and capital enhancement projects in Mountrail and Williams County. These funds are designed to improve the quality of life of MWEC members and positively impact the economic development of their communities. To qualify for a grant, the project must fit within one of the grant focus areas.

Funding Parameters

\$2501 - \$25,000 depending on the scope and impact of project.

Who can apply?

All non-profit and not-for-profit organizations within Williams and Mountrail counties.

*Funding decisions are made at the sole discretion of the MWEC Board of Directors.



Important Dates

Applications can be submitted at any time throughout the year.

Awarded annually in January

- All applications must be received by October 31
