THE HAUGEN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The Haugen Family Scholarship is designated for qualified applicants who plan to achieve a degree while attending a two-year college, four-year college or certified Vocational or Technical school. Emphasis will be placed on individuals seeking a degree in engineering or other energy related field of study.

Individuals who graduated or will be graduating from a high school in Mountrail or Williams county are eligible to apply.

HOW MUCH IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

MWEC will award one (1) Haugen Family Scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 each year.

Checks will be made payable to the school and will be distributed to the school by MWEC in August.

SCHOLARSHIP INTENT

Scholarships must be used for educational costs such as tuition, student fees, textbooks, room and board, etc.

Students must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is awarded.

HOW ARE THE RECIPIENTS SELECTED?

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, a statement of education and career goals, and an outside appraisal.

The Haugen Family Scholarship will be awarded without regard to other awards, loans or financial assistance the applicant may have obtained.

The scholarship review is two-tiered

1. All applications will be reviewed by the MWEC Board scholarship committee.
2. Top candidates will be voted upon by the entire MWEC Board of Directors.

WHAT ARE THE RECIPIENT'S OBLIGATIONS?

All scholarship recipients are required to provide the following information no later than July 1.

- College name and address
- College student identification number
