

Rates

Residential rate

8.4 cents for the first 1200 KWH and 7.2 cents for the remaining KWH

Heat rate

3.8 cents per KWH, October through April.

This heat rate is available to residential and commercial members with electric heat installations that meet the requirements below.

A member's electric heating installation must be a permanent electric resistance and/or heat pump. The electric heat load must be a minimum of 8 KW (or 8000 watts).

The electric heat must be separately sub-metered. MWEC will furnish the metering equipment. Qualifying members will furnish and have installed at their expense any wiring necessary to permit the sub-metering or all the electric heat load.

MWEC and its power supplier reserve the right to inspect all electric heat installations and associated metering installations.

Air conditioning rate

4.3 cents per KWH, May through September.

Heat and air conditioning must be metered separately to receive these discounted rates.

Water Heater Program

If you qualify for this program, MWEC will supply at no cost to you, an electric water heater for any new installation, replacement of a gas water heater or replacement for a failed water heater. MWEC will supply, install and maintain the load management control devices, however the installation of the actual water heater is *your* responsibility.

Read the following to see if you qualify for a FREE electric water heater.

You must be a MWEC member.

Your existing water heater must have failed to the point where repairs are no longer practical.

You must sign an agreement to stay under load management control for at least five years.

The controlled water heater must be your primary source of hot water at your primary residence.

The minimum tank size to be controlled is 40 gallons.



Grain Drying Program

5.4 cents per KWH (kilowatt hour)

When the weather conditions are less than favorable during harvest, farmers have no choice but to get their crop harvested and in the bin. This is why an efficient and dependable grain drying system, at a reasonable rate, is essential. MWEC is pleased to offer this successful program to the members. It's available for the farmer who needs fans for conditioning or adding heat to lower the humidity and moisture content of their grain.

Program Information

The discounted rate of 5.4 cents per KWH applies to electric dryers and fans.

A minimum load, including fan and heater, must be 5 KW (kilowatts) to qualify.

Your heaters and fans can either be sub-metered or separately metered, depending on the distance from your farm's master meter. Under certain circumstances, base charges will apply.

Loans are also available for the installation of grain drying equipment.

Loan Program
